Based on the information and test reports from TUV SUD (Document 75947245, Report 1, Issue 1, dated November 21, 2019, and Document 75946431 Report 01 Issue 2, dated December 19, 2019), we accept the EPIRB1 Pro as meeting the relevant requirements of RTCM Standard 11000.3 and COSPAS-SARSAT C/S T.007 Class 2 (occasional polar transit), Category 1 (automatic release) in accordance with 46 CFR 161.011 and 47 CFR 80.1061.
